**NOTE**: On-site camping is available only to those participating in or attending an event or activity at the WEC. This includes overnight stalling of livestock. All others or those desiring full hookups, showers, swimming pool and other amenities are encouraged to utilize one of the three commercial RV parks located in Winnemucca. Dry camping and a limited number of additional locations with electrical is available throughout the facilities.

#### Camping Fees

Campsites w/30 amp outlet (Electricity/Water/Sewer) — \$25/night

Standard Campsites (Electricity/Water ONLY) — \$20/night

Dry Camping (No electricity, water or sewer hookups) — \$10/night

#### **Stall Fees (PER NIGHT PER HORSE)**

Box Stalls, Covered Stalls, Uncovered Stalls – \$10/night per stall per horse

#### **Reservations for Campsites and Stalls**

Campsite and stall reservations will be assigned in order received. All other camping / stall rental is first come, first serve. Camping & Stall reservation form and fees must be turned in by Team Representative prior to **February 16, 2018**. Please provide a list of all names in your group for emergency purposes. Cancellations will be accepted up to 7 days prior to start of event. No refunds after that time. For additional information regarding reservations call Karen at (775) 385-0509.

**IMPORTANT**: Each camping vehicle or tent must possess and display, in a prominent location, a valid camping permit. Camping or using power without said permit may result in a citation per NRS 205.445

#### **Camping & Facility Rules**

- Non-contained fires for cooking or heating are not permitted.
- ♦ All campsites must be kept clean for the enjoyment of all occupants. Occupants must clean up after their livestock/pets.
- Livestock may not be tied to camping vehicle or in temporary stalls in campsite at night (must use permanent stalls/pens).
- Dogs must be controlled at all times. Do not allow your dog to run free or pose a threat to other campers or livestock. Dogs not allowed in grandstands or other buildings. PLEASE KEEP DOGS ON LEASHES AT ALL TIMES. Dogs not allowed in Event Center.
- ♦ Generators are only allowed to run from 6am to 10pm. Please be considerate of those around you. If it is not absolutely necessary to run your generator, DON'T!
- Quiet time is from 10pm to 6am. This includes radios, barking dogs and parties. Any guest, their children, or their visitors who become a nuisance will be asked to leave the grounds.
- All garbage is to be deposited in containers provided. Please leave your area as clean as you found it.
