Rules and Regulations for Winnemucca's RHR Barrel Bash

The Winnemucca RHR Barrel Bash will be held in conjunction with the Winnemucca Ranch Hand Rodeo Weekend. The Barrel Bash will be held Friday, March 2, Saturday, March 3 and Sunday, March 4, 2018. Please see Online Entry Form for a complete list of all races. The RHR Barrel Races will be held in the **Covered Arena**. Full refund (less any credit card processing fees) will be given if event is cancelled due to weather.

- 1. We accept all major credit cards via ONLINE entry and CASH ONLY day of race. Checks are not accepted as a form of payment.
- 2. Winnemucca RHR Barrel Bash reserves the right to refuse service to anyone.
- 3. We will not tolerate the inhumane treatment of any animal at our facility.
- 4. Open Race will be a 4D Format ½ second, 1 second and 2 seconds split.
- 5. Open Average 100% Payback will be based on Saturday/Sunday run.
- 6. 3 ½ D Side Pot Race CARRY OVER ONLY 90% Payback based off Open's fast time.
- 7. Over N Under Race will be a 4D Format ½ second, 1 second and 2 seconds split. This class is restricted to participants 50 & Over and 15 & Under as of January 1, 2018.
- 8. Time Only's are available to purchase online with entry. Friday 9 am 4:30 pm, Saturday 8 am 10 am, Sunday 8 am 9:30 am.
- 9. All runs will be in the new Covered Arena on the North side of the Indoor Event Center.
- 10. Co-Sanctioned with SIBRA, BBR and BRN4D.
- 11. Late entries, which would like to be included in the late draw, must be entered by runner number 50. Late entries will be taken until last runner runs and put at the end of the late draw. Late fee is \$25 per person or trip to the office.
- 12. There is a \$25 change fee.
- 13. An electric timer will be used.
- 14. Ground will be tractor raked after every 5 runs big drag every 50.
- 15. The 5 in the drag must be in the holding pen before the end of the drag or you will be turned out.
- 16. All riders will be given 3 minutes from the first gate call to leave the holding pen and begin their run.
- 17. A contestant will be given a "no time" for any knocked down barrels or broken pattern. If you go off course you may complete your pattern, but MAY NOT re-circle a barrel.
- 18. Once the draw is posted it is FINAL. The draw will not be changed or given preference to any contestant for the sole purpose of accommodating their schedule or calendar.
- 19. In the event of an electric eye failure, the rider will be given a re-ride option or their entry fee's refunded. As much accommodation as possible will be given to the contestant/horse.
- 20. Vet or Sick out 70% of entry will be refunded to your credit card when Vet or Doctor release is received. Please email to: fairgrounds@wmca.net We cannot accept vet outs after the race has begun.
- 21. Full western attire with hats/helmets, boots and long sleeve western shirt with collar and cuffs (NO long sleeve tees).
- 22. \$5 Donation to be given to the barrel setter if you lose your hat in the arena.
- 23. Checks will be mailed, if not present, within 10 business days of race.
- 24. All dogs are to be on a leash at all times. No dogs are allowed inside any building with the exception of service dogs.

- 25. If you would like to have your horses stalled near another contestant or to have your RV/Camping spots near another contestant, one of you must purchase the number of total stalls or RV/Camping spots you'll need in order for you to be placed by someone. We cannot guarantee specific locations with multiple people purchasing stalls or RV camping spots.
- 26. You may pre-purchase your shavings with your entry or purchase them upon arrival at site.
- 27. **STALL AND CAMPING FEES**: Stall fees are \$10 per horse per night. The Winnemucca Events Complex has box stalls, covered pens or outside pens. No horses will be tied overnight to fences or trailers. NO panels allowed. No stall refunds after 2/28/18 we will assist you in selling your stall if you are not able to attend. Campsites are available for \$20/night (includes access to water and electricity) or \$25/night (includes sewer hookup, access to water and electricity). Dry Camping is \$10/night (no water, no electricity and no sewer hookup). For stalls and campsites, go to the Online Entry From RanchRodeoNV.com
- 28. There shall be NO selling of any type of merchandise or professional service on the area grounds, in stalls or at trailers without prior approval from the Winnemucca Event Complex staff. All advertisements, flyers, posters or brochures must be pre-approved before being hung on grounds or posted on social media. DO NOT hang flyers on any glass or paint as there will be designated boards.
- 29. Tickets for the Winnemucca Ranch Hand Rodeo can be pre-purchased during the entry process. They will be \$10 for a two-day wrist band. Wristbands are non-refundable.
